We highly recommend all delegates to write a position paper for their respective country and committee topics. It is an essential preparation and makes the start into the conference a lot easier.

What is a position paper?

The aim of FlensMUN is to create a realistic simulation. It is therefore necessary that delegates are aware of their country's position. This paper briefly outlines the country's position in regard to the matters discussed. It should include the following information:

- Country's position on the topic
- Country's relation to the topic
- Proposals of policies to pass in a resolution

Note: The position paper should be max. 1 page per committee topic.

You also have the opportunity to have your position paper read by your committee's chair. They will be able to give you feedback so that you can be as well prepared as possible. The deadline in order to receive feedback is the 30th of June 2025.
